

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- Greet, assist, and thank customer; give customer clear directions on how to navigate the pump area and entrance; pump gas; check and replenish oil in vehicle; check and replenish windshield washer fluid in vehicle; service multiple vehicles simultaneously
- Sell wash services and products; prepare wash ticket; mark window for services purchased; assist in timing customer visits; communicate with management and other team members using a walkie-talkie
- Inspect vehicle for prior damage and for retractable antenna and phone antenna; ask customer to lower or remove antennas
- Maintain a clean and safe environment, clean gas pumps, nozzles, and pump island areas; empty trash cans; stock windshield cleaner buckets and squeegees
- Clean wash equipment and walls
- Follow company policies, procedures, rules, directives, and instructions
- Perform other functions as required

JOB REQUIREMENTS AND QUALIFICATIONS:

- Ability to bend, stoop, lift up to 50 pounds, pull, push, reach, climb, wipe, stand, walk, run, kneel, stretch, read, write, see, hear, understand, and talk
- Ability to hear and respond quickly to: wash buzzers, squealing tires, revving engines, honking horns, and other audible warning signs
- Current valid driver's license
- Ability to drive vehicles with automatic and standard transmissions
- Ability to work independently, to exercise good judgment, to work and assist customers quickly, and to work under pressure
- Ability to work in heat and cold, and in sunshine, wind, snow, sleet, rain, and other adverse weather
- Ability to sell to customers
- Ability to be at work regularly, on time, and predictably, to work an assigned schedule, and, if required, to work extended hours, weekends, and/or holidays
- Ability to work in a team environment, and to interact well with Waterway management, co-workers, and customers
- Does not pose a direct threat to the health or safety of others in the workplace
- Professional appearance, demeanor, and attitude
- Knowledge of wash services and c-store products
